11. Why might this help these lizards survive?

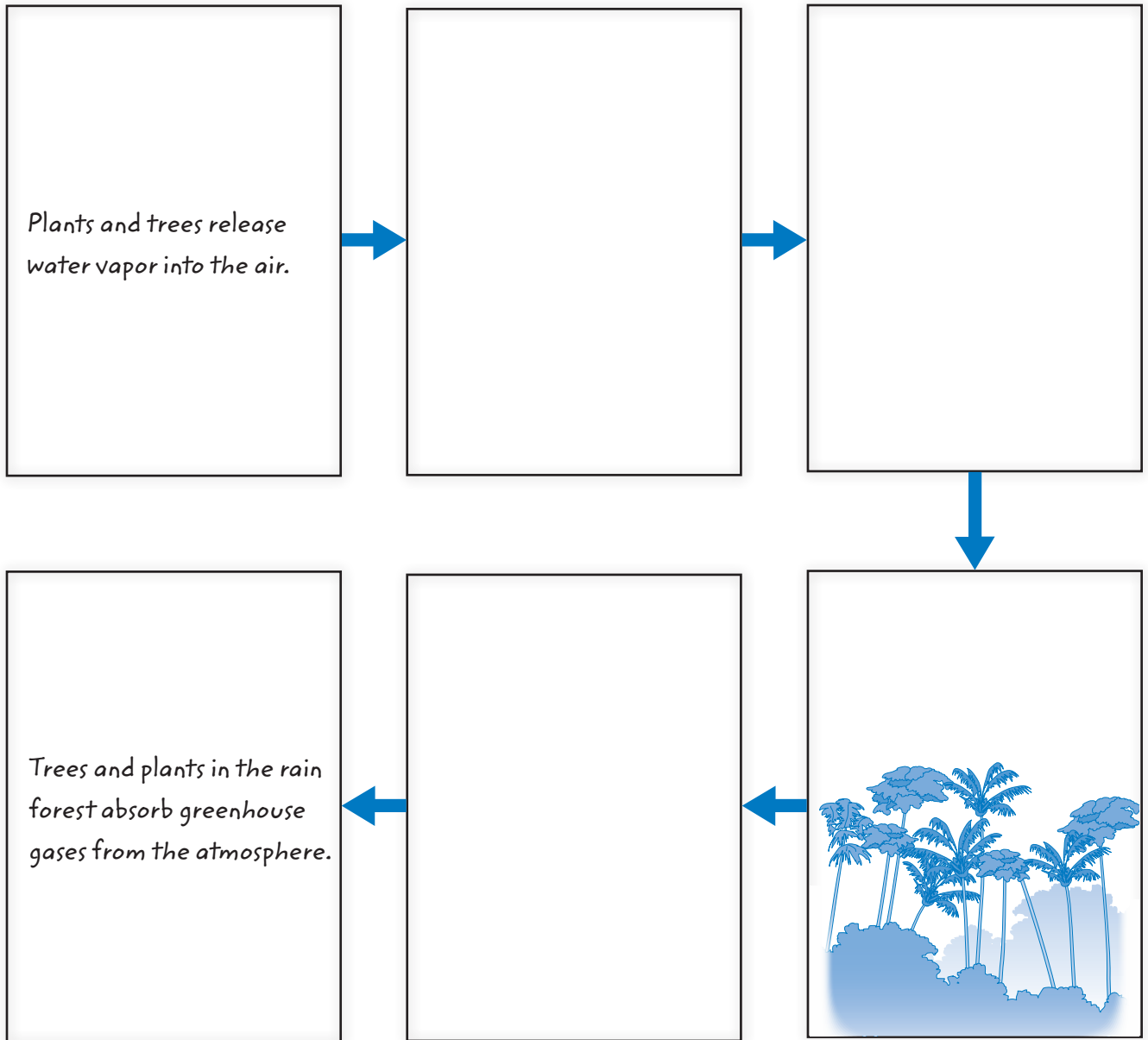
